Individual Winners Announced for NC TECH Awards

RALEIGH, N.C. (October 8, 2018) – Individual winners for the <u>NC TECH Awards</u>, North Carolina's only statewide technology awards program, have been announced by <u>NC TECH</u>. This awards program recognizes companies, organizations and individuals for their achievement, innovation and leadership throughout the year.

After a nomination period earlier this summer, finalists and winners were chosen in a two-stage review process, led by the accounting firm Cherry Bekaert, in partnership with an independent selection committee. The awards process culminates with the NC TECH Awards Gala on November 15, at the Sheraton Imperial Hotel & Convention Center in Durham, where nearly 800 leaders will gather to celebrate the tech sector and honor finalists in each category. Winners will be announced live that evening.
