RECRUITING with PURPOSE



DATA SUMMARY

May 2019 saw another slight dip in open technology positions from the previous month, but it still showed a **14.5% increase** from May 2018. There were **28,368 open positions** for the month, with the majority concentrated in Charlotte and Raleigh. Greensboro showed strong growth with a 50.5% increase in open IT positions from May 2018.

Middleware software has exploded in growth from last year at **12,750%**, followed by Kubernetes with 110% growth. The **wholesale trade** and **retail** industries are driving the increase in IT jobs. Each grew over 20% from this time last year. **IBM** and **Cisco** are the largest sources of IT job postings this month. Cisco showed the strongest growth at 167.7%.

SUPPLY & DEMAND SNAPSHOT: KAFKA

Kafka has been a steady presence on the top ten skills list over the course of the year. The open-source software platform has become instrumental in real-time data analytics and has grown in job postings over 104% from 2018. It has been implemented and heavily used by tech giants such as LinkedIn, Netflix, and Twitter. Let's take a closer look at the employment market surrounding this growing skillset.

- **Demand Pressure**: Over the course of May 2019, there were 812 jobs requiring Kafka experience in North Carolina. Over the past year, there have been 3,067 in total. In a reflection of the current talent shortage, there is an average of 7 job openings for each candidate in the state. Nationally, this increases to 11 jobs per candidate.
- Certifications: Certifications can help an individual stand out when working with Kafka. The
 <u>Confluent Certified Developer for Apache Kafka (CCDAK)</u> program is the first certification
 program developed for the skillset and has become one of the most widely recognized in the
 tech industry. Professionals also have the option to become a Confluent Certified Administrator
 for Apache Kafka (CCAK).
- **Job Titles:** Common job titles for individuals with Kafka experience include: Software Engineer, Data Engineer, Hadoop DevOps Engineer, Java Developer, and Data Architect.
