

DATA SUMMARY

The technology job market for 2019 remains strong for the second month in a row. The number of job postings grew over 3% from January to reach **28,634 jobs** in February. This is over a 40% increase from the same month last year. **Software Developer** jobs grew almost 73% to remain in the top spot for IT occupations.

Java is still the top skill for those in technical professions. It showed modest growth of 58.6% from 2018. DevOps is a new addition to the skills list, coming in at number 10. This skill grew 130% from 2018 to reach 2,866 jobs. The information industry has definitively pulled ahead in technology hiring, growing 81.5% from February 2018.

SUPPLY & DEMAND SNAPSHOT: DEVOPS

This month, we focus on a skill that is not only one of the top 10 most requested skills in job postings, but also one of the top 10 fastest growing. According to the 2017 State of DevOps report published by Puppet and DORA, the number of individuals employed in DevOps has nearly doubled since 2014 from 16% to 27%. Here's what the North Carolina DevOps job market looks like today.

- **Demand Pressure**: Over the course of February 2019, there were 2,866 jobs requiring DevOps in North Carolina. In a reflection of the current talent shortage, there is an average of 10 job openings for each candidate in the state. Nationally, this increases to 14 jobs per candidate.
- **Certifications:** There are a number of certifications that can help an individual stand out when working with DevOps. The <u>AWS Certified DevOps Engineer Professional</u> certification is meant for those in a DevOps Engineer role. The <u>DevOps Institute</u> offers courses and certifications ranging from a DevOps Foundation Certification to Certified Agile Process Owner (CAPO).
- **Job Titles:** Common job titles for individuals with DevOps experience include: Cloud Engineer Architect, Software Engineer, Test Automation Engineer, and Linux Engineer.
