## NORTH CAROLINA'S 2019 STATE OF TECHNOLOGY INDUSTRY REPORT RELEASED Findings Reveal the Continued Vibrancy of the State's Tech Sector

**RALEIGH, NC – February 4, 2019 –** The <u>North Carolina Technology Association (NC TECH)</u> has released its fifth annual overview of the state's tech sector. The Report provides an overview of the tech sector's impact on North Carolina's economy, including workforce composition and salary information, along with a comparison to other states in various categories.

A few key findings in the Report include:

- North Carolina ranks #3 in job growth in total tech employment growth from 2012-2017
- North Carolina once again ranks #1 in percentage of its tech workforce made up of women
- North Carolina ranks 6<sup>th</sup> ranked state for Startups created from University tech transfer
- North Carolina has moved into the top 15 states for venture capital investment
- For the next five years, North Carolina is projected to be in the Top 5 highest growth states for both tech industry jobs and tech occupations jobs

The <u>North Carolina State of Technology Industry Report (NCSTIR)</u> is a resource for policy makers, economic developers, media, and the tech community, with the goal of identifying strengths and opportunities that can lead to further economic growth.
