Tech Innovation Index

In December 2021, NC TECH released the first Tech Innovation Index. The Index compares the state's metros' tech performance against other top metros in the country. The methodology, developed with input from tech leaders, uses a list of metrics grouped into three subindexes: tech talent supply, tech talent demand and innovation. The data used to compare metro tech performance is released annually and will be used to assess year after year. The deliverable includes a national map with the 100 metros included in the index and a published Report. Learn more at nctech.org/research.
