



#### **WOMEN IN STEM SCHOLARSHIP**

North Carolina scores a top spot for employment of women in the tech industry: an impressive #2 behind the state of Maine (Source: NC State of the Technology Industry Report). While this ranking is something to be proud of, the percentage of women in tech is only 36.5% for North Carolina.

NC TECH supports women in STEM through programming and the annual <u>Summit for Women in TECH</u>, but also through efforts around career exploration for students through initiatives such as Code.org's Hour of Code and First Robotics and the <u>Betsy Y. Justus Founders Scholarship</u>. The scholarship application is now open to high school seniors, headed to an NC college or university, with an intent to study information technology or engineering. Please share with parents/students, as well as with any organizations with which you may be involved that can help amplify the opportunity. Winners are awarded \$4,000 (\$1,000/year) and a Lenovo laptop.
