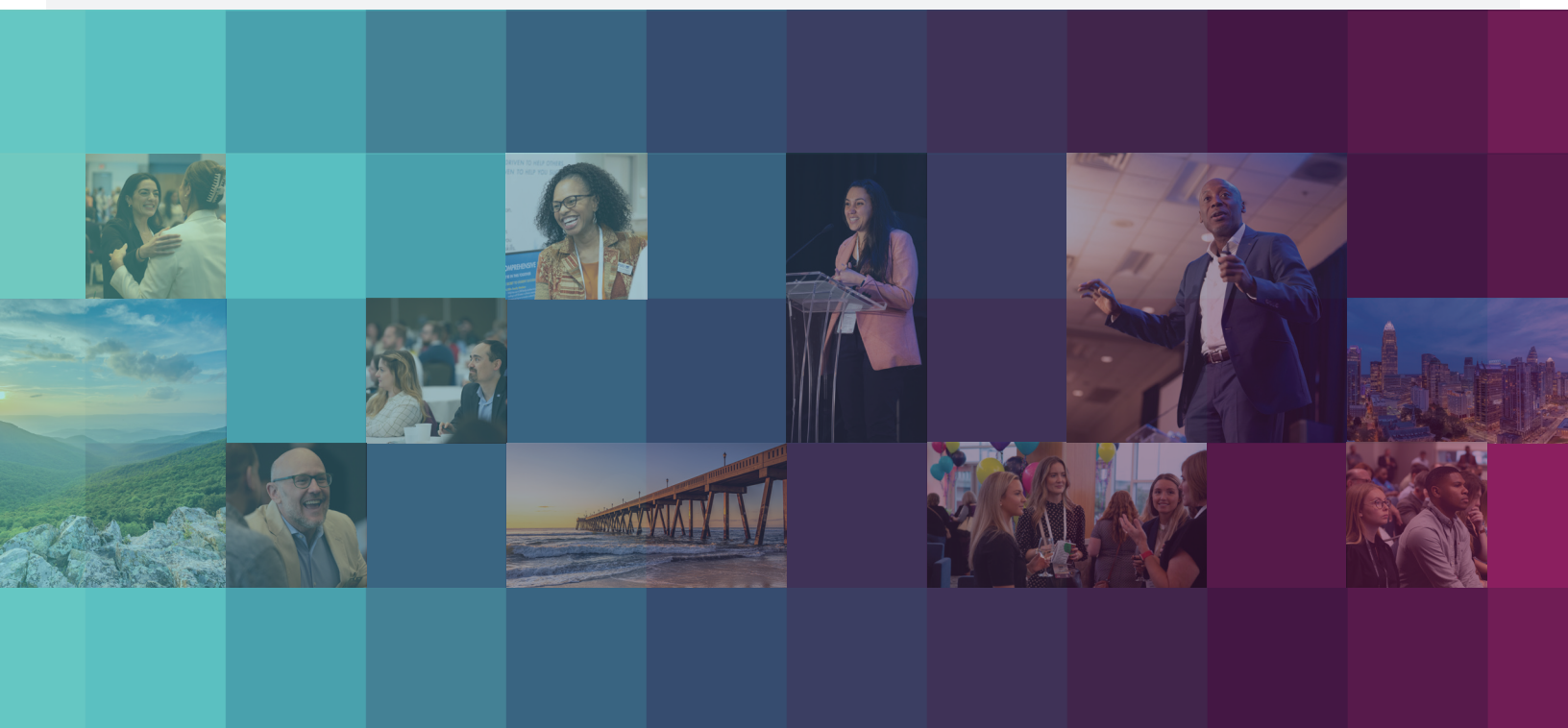

NEXT TECH AWARDS

The NEXT TECH Awards program, presented by NC TECH and Business North Carolina, recognizes critical, non-C-suite contributors who go the extra mile, build products, grow revenue, support operations, and run the projects that propel businesses forward. The winners will be celebrated during a reception on May 22 at the Durham Convention Center and will be featured in the June issue of Business North Carolina. 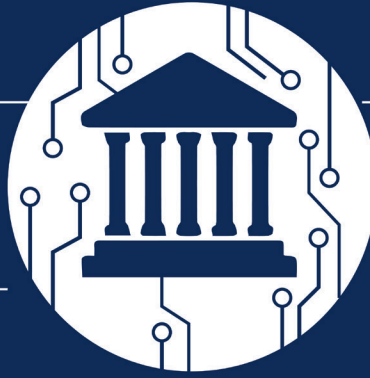
Executive Private Dinners · \$5,000 plus the cost of dinner (Exclusive)

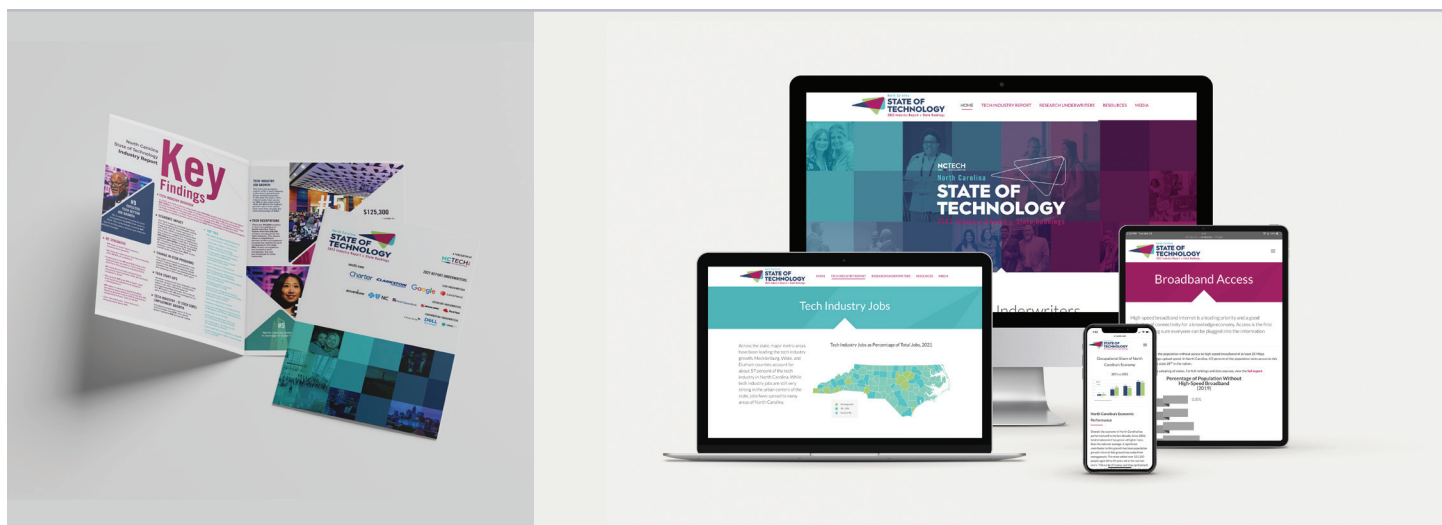
2024 RESEARCH UNDERWRITERS MENU

ANNUAL

The NC STIR, first released in January 2015, highlights the vibrancy and immense economic impact of North Carolina's technology sector. The data is used to track the tech industry, identify results to celebrate and identify issues that affect the states competitiveness for policy makers. The report includes facts, trends and insights into North Carolina's technology industry along with state rankings. Deliverables include a dedicated website (www.NCSTIR.com), a published Key Findings summary and live briefings to present highlights of the data collection.



IT JOB TRENDS DASHBOARD *New*

MONTHLY

The new IT Job Trends dashboard provides an overview of the tech employment landscape in North Carolina, offering a snapshot of IT job postings for the most recent month, both in North Carolina and across the United States. The dashboard includes lists of top job titles, in-demand skills, leading hiring companies, and wage rates. A 13-month chart visualizes job opening trends over the past year, with an extended view covering the last five years. Leveraging data from Lightcast, this dashboard is designed to offer valuable insights to both tech employers and professionals as they evaluate the employment market. Each month, we release a snapshot of the dashboard with graphics to our members and the media, featuring data from the previous month.

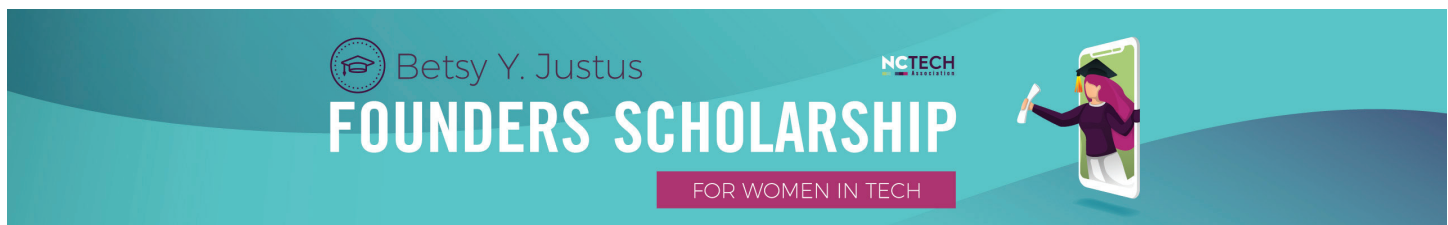
