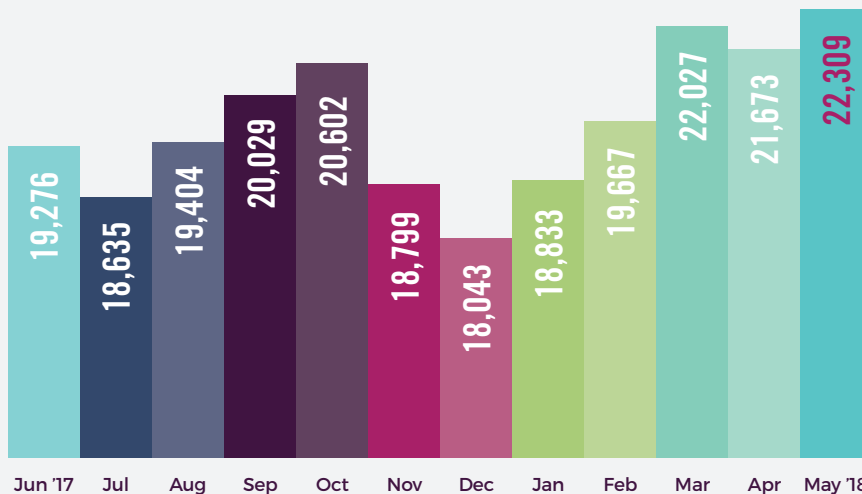

June 2018



DATA SUMMARY

There were 22,309 tech job postings listed in North Carolina in the month of May, the highest number of postings listed in over a year. This is an **increase** of over **1,800 positions** when compared to last month's report and 10.9% higher than May 2017's numbers.

Industries that saw the highest increase in job postings include **finance and insurance**, **retail**, and **educational services**, with each industry posting at least **19% more** job opportunities compared to last year. Computer Systems Analyst is the only position to see a drop in activity. **Raleigh, Durham-Chapel Hill, Wilmington**, and **Fayetteville** all continue to see the highest rates of growth in the state compared to 2017.

WHAT'S TRENDING IN RECRUITING?



Each month, we share the top 10 job titles, skills, and companies in North Carolina. This month, we are showcasing some of the **trends to watch** that did not make the top 10 list:

- Emerging technologies that are experiencing the greatest growth are cloud-based or open source development technologies. Security-related skills are also on the rise. These include:
 - Docker (+90.49%)
 - Maven (+89.57%)
 - DevOps (+83.81%)
 - Azure (+68.86%)
 - Data modeling (+68.20%)
 - Jenkins (+67.89%)
 - Amazon Web Services (+67.02%)
 - Infrastructure as a Service (+59.30%)
 - Node.js (+55.86%)
 - Atlassian JIRA (+55.77%)
 - Cyber security (+52.04%)
- Conversely, it is interesting to note that skills that have decreased the most in job postings compared to last year include:
 - System administration (-20.85%)
 - Network security (-16.12%)
 - Application design (-15.55%)
 - Systems integration (-14.32%)
 - ASP.NET (-14.14%)
 - LAN (-13.34%)
 - WAN (-12.12%)
 - VMware (-11.28%)
